

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
THE UNITED STATES SECTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL JOINT
COMMISSION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY (1998)
Amendment 12

ARTICLE II – SCOPE

Insert new paragraph Q. as follows:

Q. The New England District Corps of Engineers shall lead the development of a reservoir simulation model of the reservoir system for the St. Croix watershed, including East Grand, Spednic, West Grand and Grand Falls Reservoirs. This shall include compiling basic reservoir data, developing flow data for a defined historic period, and, given operational constraints, running simulations, and reproducing historic system operation to the extent possible. A HEC RES SIM model will be used at a monthly time step. The deliverable is a brief report documenting: model development, assumptions, summary and findings. The report shall also contain the final version of the model. A draft report will be given to the IJC for review by May 30, 2006. The final report shall incorporate any comments from IJC or its International St. Croix River Board and be provided to IJC by June 20, 2006.

ARTICLE V – FUNDING

In the first paragraph, last line, after section O: delete “and”, and

In the first paragraph, last line, after section P: delete the period and insert “; and \$50,000 for Article II, section Q.”

ARTICLE VIII – RESPONSIBILITY FOR COSTS

In the first paragraph, line 4: delete “\$561,900.” and insert “\$611,900.”

This Amendment 12 shall be effective when signed by both the U.S. Section and the Department of the Army.
