

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
THE UNITED STATES SECTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL JOINT  
COMMISSION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY (1998)  
Amendment 9

**ARTICLE II – SCOPE**

Insert new paragraph N. as follows:

N. The Detroit District, Corps of Engineers shall assist the IJC in revising its January 2002 Upper Great Lakes Plan of Study into a new Upper Lakes Plan of Study by providing leadership and facilitating a team of bi-national experts appointed by the Commission (Upper Lakes Plan of Study Revision Team) to revise said document. The effort will include conducting public meetings on the draft report. The effort will be conducted consistent with the Commissions' Upper Lakes Plan of Study Directive to the team dated May 12, 2005. The deliverable will be the revised and final Upper Lakes Plan of Study which will need to be provided to the Commission by Friday October 14, 2005.

**ARTICLE V – FUNDING**

In the first paragraph, last line, after section L: delete “and”, and

In the first paragraph, last line, after section M: delete the period and insert “; and \$22,000 for Article II, section N.”

**ARTICLE VIII – RESPONSIBILITY FOR COSTS**

In the first paragraph, line 4: delete “\$419,900.” and insert “\$441,900.”

This Amendment 9 shall be effective when signed by both the U.S. Section and the Department of the Army.
