

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE UNITED STATES SECTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL JOINT COMMISSION
AND
THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY
Amendment 7

ARTICLE II – SCOPE

Insert new paragraph L. as follows:

- L. The Institute for Water Resources (IWR) shall support a Commission meeting concerning improved organizational effectiveness pursuant to the *Boundary Waters Treaty of 1909* and the *Great Lakes Water Quality Agreement of 1978*. The support shall include advance preparation to explore relevant issues, development of an agenda, travel to and facilitation of the meeting, and preparation of a report within two weeks following conclusion of the meeting documenting primary findings.

ARTICLE V – FUNDING

In the first paragraph, last line, after Section J: delete “and”, and in the first paragraph, last line, after Section K: delete the period and insert “; and \$6,000 for Article II, Section L.”.

ARTICLE VIII – RESPONSIBILITY FOR COSTS

In the first paragraph, line 4: delete “\$388,900.” and insert “\$394,900.”

This Amendment 7 shall be effective when signed by both the U.S. Section and the DA.
