

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE
UNITED STATES AGENCY FOR INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT
AND THE
U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS
TO TRANSFER FUNDS

I. AUTHORITY

Under Section 632(a) of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended (the "FAA"), and the Foreign Operations, Export Financing and Related Programs Appropriations Act, 2000 (Public Law 106-113), the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) hereby agrees to transfer to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers \$100,000 in funds appropriated for Economic Support Fund.

II. PURPOSE


The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will use the funds transferred under this Memorandum of Agreement to perform a site survey and an evaluation of the Kainji Dam in Nigeria. Funds transferred hereunder are available for obligation and expenditure for the purposes for which such funds are authorized, in accordance with authority granted in the FAA or authority governing the activities of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.

III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A. USAID will transfer the funds from its account 720/11037 to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' account 96 0/1 3121 by means of a Nonexpenditure Transfer Authorization (Standard Form 1151).

B. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will administer the funds transferred under this Memorandum of Agreement in accordance with all applicable law. The Army Corps of Engineers shall be the agency responsible and accountable for the management, audit and use of such funds.
