

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
THE UNITED STATES SECTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL JOINT COMMISSION
AND THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY (1998)

Amendment 14

ARTICLE II – SCOPE

Insert new paragraphs U, and V as follows:

U. The New England District Corps of Engineers shall assist the IJC and its St. Croix River Board by developing a rainfall-runoff model (HEC-HMS) that will be tied into ResSIM to allow for simulations of projected rainfall conditions and evaluation of effects of different methods of operating the reservoirs. The complete model of the watershed will cost \$192,000. The IJC will provide \$192,000 (U.S.) for this effort. The deliverable is the completed rainfall-runoff model for the St Croix River Watershed, and the completed model will be presented to IJC by September 2007 under this agreement.

V. The New England District Corps of Engineers will lead in the organization and conducting of a “Stakeholder Participation Workshop” that will focus on presenting the GIS/Mapping deliverables that USACE has created for the St. Croix River Watershed, as well as the mapping deliverables that will be created as a result of the St Croix Bi-national Watershed and Hydrologic Mapping Pilot Project workshops. This work will be conducted in close collaboration and partnership with USGS. The workshop will demonstrate to the St. Croix River Watershed end-users/decision-makers how to use the products to make informative decisions. The workshop will be valuable to the stakeholders because after its completion they will be able to access and utilize all available mapping products for the St. Croix River Watershed. The workshop will include 2 facilitators from USACE and 2 facilitators from USGS and will last 4 or 5 days. The date of the workshop will be held during the first half of 2007 (March or April target) and is preferred to coincide with an International St. Croix River Board meeting. The deliverable will be a report summarizing the proceeds of the workshop, as well as recommendations for the most effective implementation of the mapping deliverables. The IJC will provide \$42,050 (U.S.) towards this effort.

ARTICLE V – FUNDING

In the first paragraph, last line, after section Q: delete “and”, and

In the first paragraph, last line, after section R: delete the period and insert “; \$192,000 for Article II, section U; and \$42,050 for Article II, section V.”

ARTICLE VIII – RESPONSIBILITY FOR COSTS

In the first paragraph, line 4: delete “\$694,500.” and insert “\$928,550.”

This Amendment 14 shall be effective when signed by both the U.S. Section and the Department of the Army.
